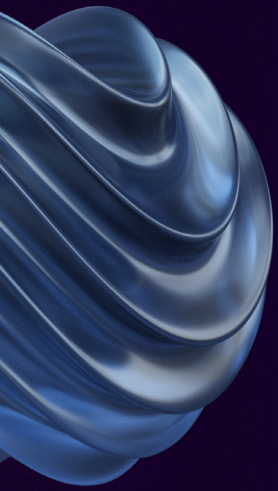

RECEIVE YOUR LETTER OF OFFER: Our admissions team will review your application and assess your prior experience, LLND skills, and English language proficiency to ensure you meet all relevant entry requirements. If approved, you will receive a Letter of Offer and an Enrolment Acceptance Agreement, which includes important pre-enrolment information.

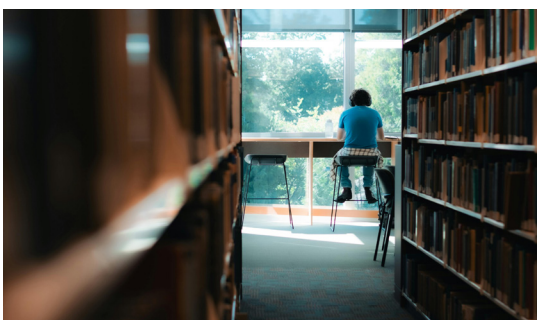
ACCEPT YOUR LETTER OF OFFER: After reviewing your Letter of Offer and pre-enrolment information, sign and return it to confirm your acceptance of the offer and the Terms and Conditions. You may then proceed with the initial payment to finalise your enrolment.

RECEIVE YOUR CONFIRMATION OF ENROLMENT: Once our admissions team receives your signed Letter of Offer and initial payment, your enrolment will be finalised. Our Student Support team will then contact you with important information including log in details and class schedule.

WELCOME LETTER: We'll send you a welcome letter confirming your course enrolment and necessary details. International students will also receive an electronic Confirmation of Enrolment (eCOE), which is required to apply for a student visa through the Department of Home Affairs to study in Australia.
