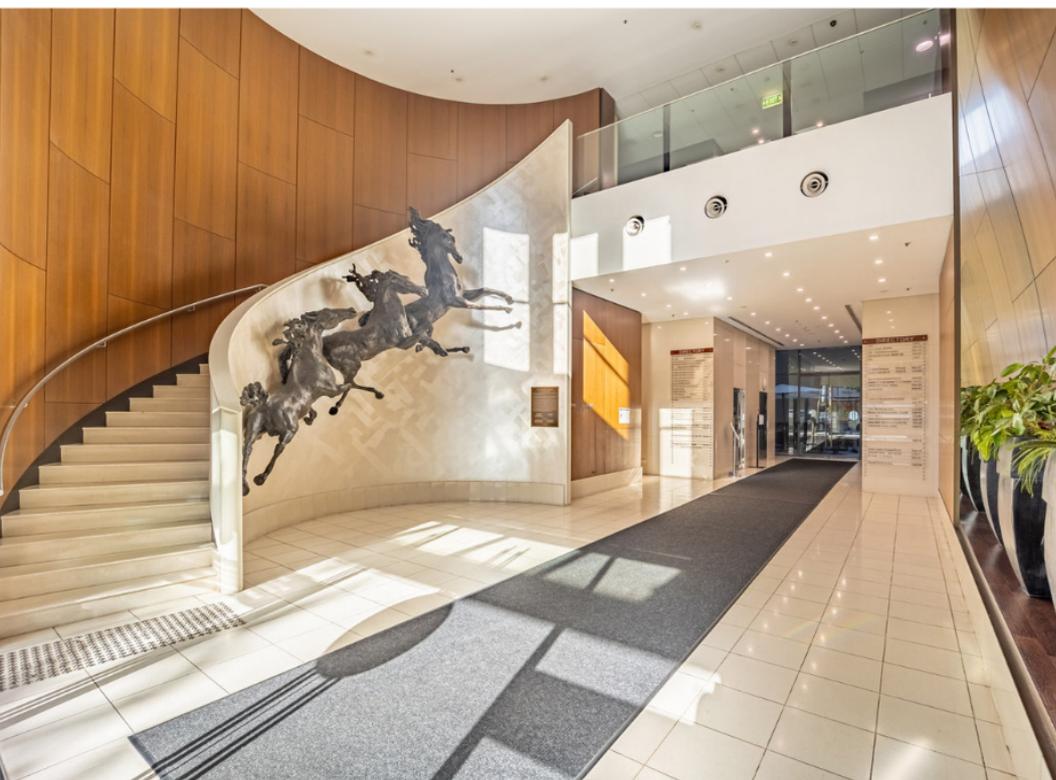



SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION: Submit an application through our online portal: www.acbi.edu.au

RECEIVE YOUR LETTER OF OFFER: Our admissions team will review your application and assess your prior experience, LLND skills, and English language proficiency to ensure you meet all relevant entry requirements. If approved, you will receive a Letter of Offer and an Enrolment Acceptance Agreement, which includes important pre-enrolment information.

ACCEPT YOUR LETTER OF OFFER: After reviewing your Letter of Offer and pre-enrolment information, sign and return it to confirm your acceptance of the offer and the Terms and Conditions. You may then proceed with the initial payment to finalise your enrolment information.

4

RECEIVE YOUR CONFIRMATION OF ENROLMENT: Once our admissions team receives your signed Letter of Offer and initial payment, you will be issued your formal Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE). Our Student Support team will then contact you with important orientation details.

5

APPLY FOR YOUR VISA: We'll send you a welcome letter confirming your course and necessary details. You'll also receive an electronic Confirmation of Enrolment document (eCOE) to apply for your student visa. You can then apply for your visa to travel to Australia via the Australian Department of Home Affairs.


